
Accessory allows you to change filter cartridges without moving your Flo King pump from the tank!


SIFCA™ attaches quickly and easily to any 650, 1200, 2500, 3000 or 5000-series system. When ordering, just specify **Flo King** pump model, pump body length, and preferred material of construction (example: "SIFCA-CPVC for BX3000-10").


To change filters, just lift SIFCA™ and allow cartridges to drain in reservoir. Then install clean cartridges. While reattaching SIFCA to pump, move O-ring with thumb to reveal vent hole (see Illustration 3), releasing air from SIFCA™. Now turn pump on and resume filtration.

SIFCA™ assembles easily and can be used with standard **Flo King** accessories. *Receiver* can be mounted to pump in any direction for preferred positioning in tank. For filter or carbon changes, simply lift *fixture* and separate from *receiver*.

SIFCA™ is ideal in cases where pipe is connected to **Flo King** pump for special agitation effects (from bottom up, for instance, as shown above). Filter cartridges can be removed without disturbing pipe, pump, or tank components.
